


Why do we need to tell time?

Second hand (Skinny hand)




In each clock the minute hand or long hand is pointing to the 12. The hour hand or small hand on the clock is pointing to the hour.



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3:00

Look at the first clock. The long hand is pointing to the 12 and the shorter hand is pointing to the 8. Therefore, the time is 8 o'clock. On the digital clock the hour is first and the minutes are at 00. So each time a digital clock has :00 for the minutes it must be right on the hour.



Telling time to the hour

- Look at the minute hand or longer hand and make sure it is pointing at the 12 on the clock
- Then look and see where the hour hand or shorter hand is pointing. The number that it is pointing to is the hour.
- When writing these times it can either be the number followed by o' clock or written in digital format which has the number, two dots, and two zeros.







The minute hand is pointing to the 6 in each picture and each digital clock says 30 for the minutes.






Telling Time to the half hour

The hour hand is pointing to the space between two numbers on each clock.






The minute hand is pointing at the 6 and the hour hand is in between the numbers 3 and 4. The hour is always the lower number, so the time is 3:30.




